Hardwood flooring from Vastern Timber is produced in our Wiltshire sawmills from English oak and other popular species grown in British woodlands. We control the whole process from sawing the logs to drying, grading and machining the finished boards.

Before producing the flooring the hardwoods are rested, air dried in the traditional manner and then kiln dried using heat generated from waste wood. These slow drying techniques ensure the floor boards are stable, flat and easy to install.

#### Specifications

Our hardwood floors are supplied in a traditional mixed width specification that will include an equal proportion of three different board widths. Boards are supplied in random lengths.

The floorboards are supplied with tongue and groove joints on the two long edges. Wide-board specifications are supplied with either square edges or with a loose tongue joint.

All boards are supplied with square ends rather than end tongue and groove. By doing this we are able to keep the boards as long as possible.

All boards are machined to be reversible, so there is always a choice of two faces.

The flooring is dried to a moisture content of approx 10–12%. We recommend that flooring is allowed to acclimatise for four to six weeks (depending on the time of year) before being laid.




Where samples are provided, please be aware that these are intended to give an indication only as to how your floor will look. Small knots and defects, variation in colour and grain pattern are all accepted as natural features that enhance this type of solid hardwood flooring.

## Unfinished British Timbers



### English oak: First grade

A floor selected from prime English oak. The boards are even coloured, with occasional small tight knots and are free of any major defects.



### English oak: Character grade

A traditional English oak floor with variations in colour and tone including small to medium sized knots, ‘cats paws’ and swirling grain.


### English oak: Barn grade

A rugged floor with a wild array of swirling grain, variation in colours, large knots, ‘cats paws’ and open splits.



### English oak: Factory grade

A narrow strip floor suitable for smaller spaces, with natural colour variations and small knots.

### English oak: Tiger brown

A darker floor with colours ranging from honey to chocolate brown, otherwise similar in quality to our Character grade oak.

### Sweet chestnut

Similar in colour to oak but with lighter tones and a more distinct grain pattern, occasional dark streaks and knots.


### Elm: Character grade

A wild floor combining the flowery grain of red elm and the vibrant green and purple colours of wych elm with knots, burrs and small cracks.

### Elm: Barn grade

Similar to the Character grade elm but with wilder grain, larger knots and open splits.

Suitable for areas with less traffic, this is a creamy white floor with occasional knots and dark mineral streaks.

### Ash: First grade

A pale floor with blond and olive tones and interesting grain patterns.

### Ash: Barn grade

A floor of varied pale tones, including dark knots and wandering heart.
